



Camp Warden Info:

General

Our primary aim is to make your visit to Camp Nor' Wes a safe, rewarding and fun experience. To accomplish this, there are a few guidelines and expectations we would ask you to review and to share with your participants. By doing so, you will enable us to ensure appropriate use of the camp facilities and the enjoyment of these facilities by your group and those who follow you.

Before You Arrive

1. Each Group must have at least one vehicle available in camp for use in case of an emergency.
2. Pets are not to run loose on camp property during Group camping, with the exception of "special needs" dogs.

When you arrive

1. The Group leader is to check in with the Camp Warden or designate.
2. Vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas only.

While You Are At Camp

1. Smoking is NOT permitted in any building. Please do not smoke in the wooded areas.
2. Fire extinguishers are provided for your safety. Please advise Camp Warden of any malfunctions with these safety items.
3. Please advise Camp Warden at once of any bear sightings.
4. Quiet time begins at 10:30 pm – noisy activities are not permitted between 10:30 pm and 7:00 am.
5. Campfires are to be built only in established campfire pits. Firewood is not available for purchase, please bring what you need.
6. Users Groups may not cut down trees on camp property. Contact the Warden to remove any hanging or potentially unsafe trees or branches.
7. Drinking water must be obtained from designated sources only.
8. Bicycle helmets are MANDATORY for anyone bicycling on camp property.
9. Firearms or non-prescription drugs are NOT permitted on camp property.
10. Youth under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult when within 10 metres of any lake.
11. The propane heaters and stoves in the Kitchen are to be turned on ONLY by the Camp Warden.
12. Charcoal Briquettes must be properly disposed of. DO NOT throw in the woods.

13. Every incident of personal injury or property damage must be reported to the Camp Warden as soon as possible after it occurs. Warden will provide guidelines as to completion of any insurance papers.
14. The area bounded by the Generator Shed/Tool Shed is out of bounds to all except designated camp staff.
15. The Camp Warden will indicate when the ice surface is open or closed for activity purposes. When open, an adult leader must be present whenever youth are on the ice.
16. In case of emergency please proceed to beach at once.
